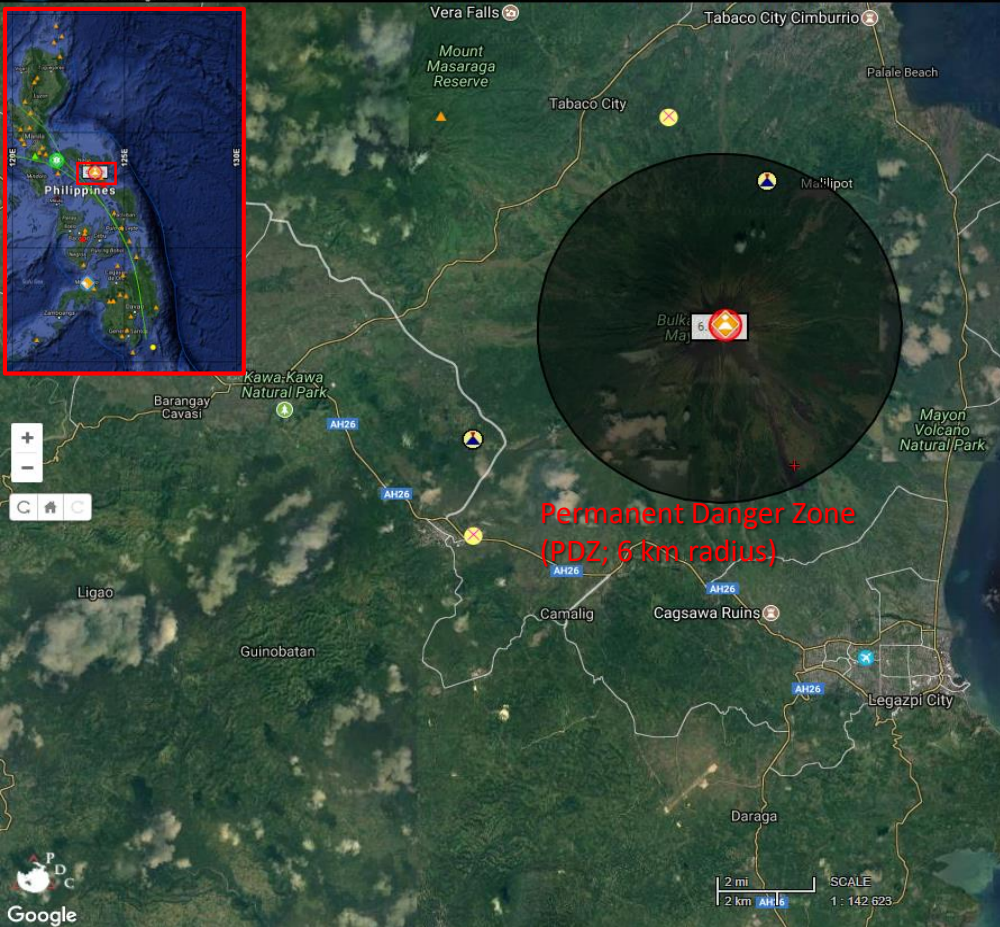

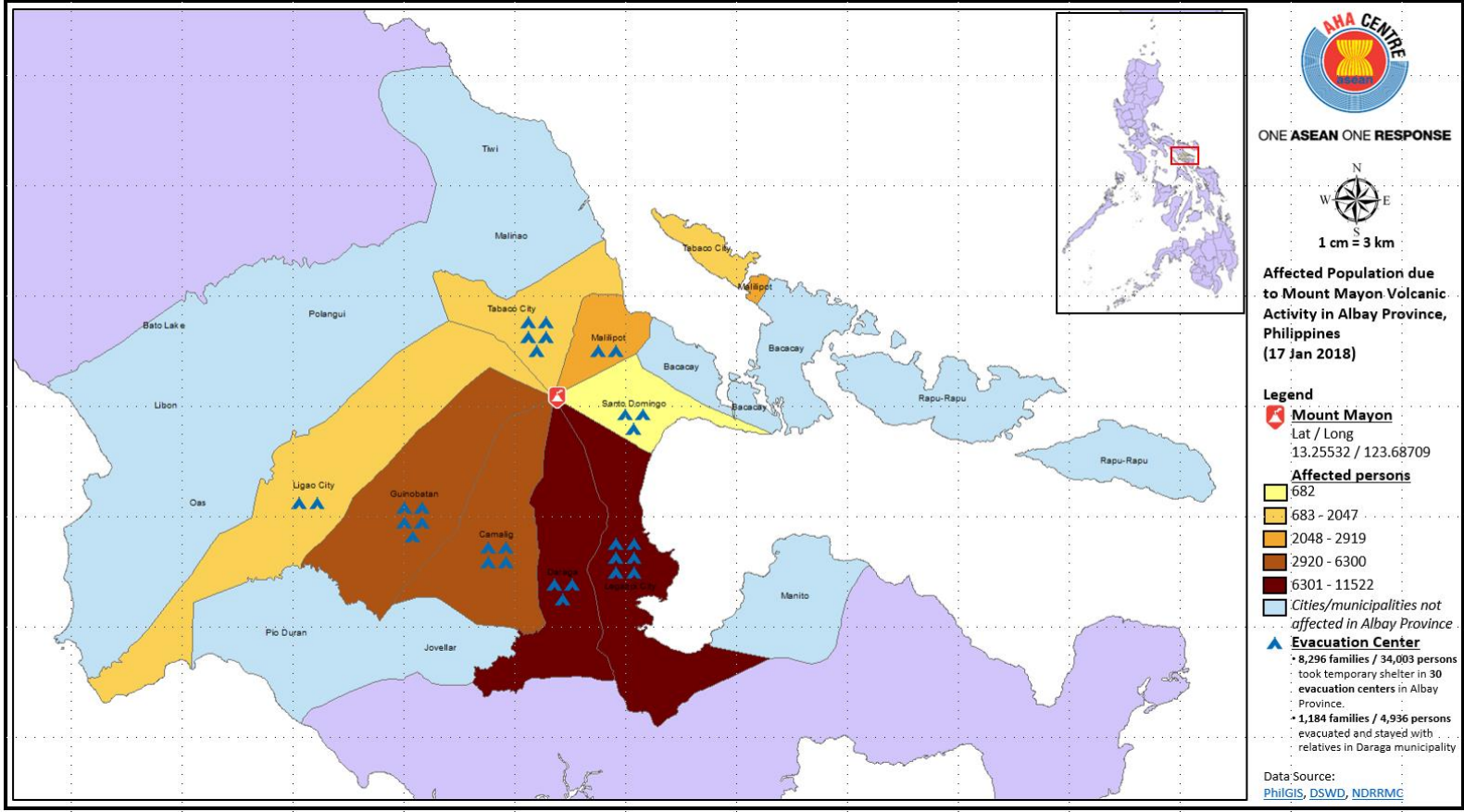

SUMMARY OF EVENT

- 1) PHIVOLCS-DOST raised Mt. Mayon's status from Alert Level 2 to Level 3 (increased tendency towards hazardous eruption) since 14-Jan-2018 20:00 UTC+8.
- 2) As of 17-Jan-2018 08:00 UTC+8 PHIVOLCS-DOST recorded 143 lava collapse events, 1 tremor, observed ash cloud drifting towards southwest, maintains Alert Level 3 and the 6 km radius of Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) & 8 km Extended Danger Zone (EDZ).
- 3) A total of 3,094 families were pre-emptively evacuated in Region V (NDRRMC).
- 4) A total of 9,480 families / 38,939 persons were affected in 36 barangays in 8 cities/municipalities in Albay Province (see figure below, [DSWD](#)).
- 5) A total of 30 evacuation centres are open and government has provided 575,605 PHP worth of assistance to affected families ([DSWD](#)).
- 6) AHA Centre is monitoring closely the situation and will provide updates if additional information becomes available.
