



Philippines

- [NDRRMC](#) reported flooding in Mamburao, Occidental Mindoro and coastal erosion in Belison, Antique. This resulted in a total of 2,401 families or 7,949 persons affected.
- A total of 2,382 families or 7,880 persons being served inside and outside 12 evacuation centres. As of 18 Jul 0800hrs (UTC+8), there were **no casualties** reported.
- Southwest Monsoon (Habagat) is enhanced by [Tropical Depression 12 \(Inday\)](#) bringing [additional rain](#) to the northern region of Philippines. The tropical depression is expected to intensify into a Tropical Storm over the next 24 hours.

Viet Nam

- [NCHMF](#) forecasted that the Tropical Storm will decrease in intensity to a Tropical Depression as it makes landfall. Heavy rainfall is expected to be concentrated in areas of Nghe An-Ha Tinh, Hoa Binh and South Son La.
- [CCNDPC](#) has issued warning for fishermen, reminded people to evacuate from areas where the storm will likely make landfall. In anticipation to the heavy rainfall, the water levels in the dams and reservoirs will be re-calculated and lowered.
- Residents in the mountainous areas have been warned of heavy rainfall, risks of landslides and were advised to stay tuned to latest updates from the local authorities.

Lao PDR

- [Department of Meteorology and Hydrology](#) forecast expects heavier rainfall between 19 and 20 Jul 2018 around Vientiane, Sainyabuli and Bolikhamsal Provinces.
